The selection committee has met five times in the past three months. We began by developing a profile of the type of minister that MacChap needs and then we identified a group of about twenty ministers who fit this profile. These twenty were narrowed to six and then to four ministers. The committee is now doing detailed study/research on these ministers (i.e listening to their sermons on the internet). At our next meeting in May the committee will develop a plan to visit the churches of the minsters that we are most impressed with. We expect that we might be able to ask the best candidate to visit us in a couple of months. At that point, the whole congregation will have the opportunity to meet him, hear him preach, and ask him questions. Please pray that God would guide us to the right person.
