SENIOR MINISTER UPDATE

The Session is pleased to give the church an update on the Call of Rev. Dave Woolcott.

The Macquarie Chapel Presbyterian Church Commissioners followed up with

the Communicant and Adherents Rolls and we were delighted that 75% were in support of the Call for Dave Woolcott. Subsequently, there has been some clarification of details of funding the Call with the Presbyterian Office [thanks to staff and Committee of Management (COM) members who worked hard on the details].

At a recent Presbytery of Sydney North meeting, the terms of the call were approved, however, it was indicated the Ryde congregation needs to have the opportunity to speak in favour/against the call. The Ryde congregation will elect Commissioners who will attend a meeting and then there will be a vote to Sustain the Call, which means that Dave will be asked if he is willing to take up the Call. That meeting will be held in mid-September, and Dave will have 30 days to respond.

Positive recent conversations between Dave, two Elders from Ryde Presbyterian Church and a group of Elders from Macquarie Chapel mean that we are now confident of a good outcome. As soon as all details are finalised we will be informing the congregation.

In the meantime we value prayers for the final stages of the process; as well as for staff, Session and COM, who continue to work hard on behalf of the congregation.
