GILGANDRA/WARREN MISSON & GIVING OPPORTUNITY FOR US

From the 27th to 30th of September, approximately 16 people from three local Presbyterian churches, including 6 from MacChap are heading Mid North West of NSW to bring blessings and support to families doing it tough in drought conditions in that region.



The team would appreciate our prayers for the trip and specifically for the following:

- Pray for their team meeting Saturday 14th September, including specific training on how to have helpful conversations with people doing it tough.
- Pray for a particular family with 4 children and one on the way. The husband doesn't have any work until early next year, as long as the crop survives.
- A praise point is that there will be donations of doll gift packs through Project Kin, which MacChap member Margaret Mayger has organised. Pray that this will bless the children in need.

According to the Gilgandra Presbyterian minister there's a real buzz in the towns with the impending visit of the city folk who care, and that it means a lot to them.

There will be an opportunity to contribute to the blessing fund for this mission, as we will take up a final **retiring offering at the end of the services today, Sept 22.** The team will bless indiviual families by visiting and providing food hampers purchased in the region.
