**This Sunday we need to do things a little differently to the way we usually would when we meet together as a church. We ask that you prayerfully consider the following in regards to this Sunday.**

- If you are at risk (e.g. elderly members or immunocompromised people), please consider carefully the wisdom of attending church.**
- We will be trialling 'live streaming' of the 10:30 and 6:30 services from the Big Hall. This might be a practice run for future weeks due to further restrictions to groups meeting together. Please consider staying at home if you are able to log into the 'live stream', especially if you have kids - due to the potential of cross-contamination between young and old. MacKids will not be running as normal, however will be watching a video (while sitting in their own 1.5m<sup>2</sup> space!).**
- If you are feeling healthy, and are as strong as an ox, and have no capability or desire to 'live stream', then we look forward to seeing you in person.**

**There is a Facebook group that you can join if you haven't yet. It may be helpful if you would like to be aware of updates more often than Re:Mac might provide. It is also a place where you can link into some community if you are isolated at this time. A place to chat, pray, encourage, etc.**

**If you are isolated and want help with shopping or other needs, please let us know at the Ministry Centre. Also, if you would like to volunteer to help others at this time, then please let us know.**

**Although these are different times, they are times that are full of opportunities to love and support each other well. Take time each day to connect with those who might be isolated. Emails, texts and messages are good but this is a great time to pick up the phone so that we can hear each other's voices!**
