FREE Scripture Teacher Training in Term 3!

Have you ever thought about what it might be like teaching scripture in Primary or High schools?



Presbyterian Youth are offering free online Special Religious Education (SRE) training for volunteers for this term only.

What that means is if you sign up and start the training before the end of term (by Sept 21), the online SRE training course of Modules 1-7 are free! You don't have to finish all modules before the end of the term, however, you do need to at least start it. All SRE teachers are required to successfully complete an approved training course prior to being eligible to teach scripture, along with a current WWCC and approval from their local church leadership.
