- -Is the question being asked from curiosity or from unprocessed emotion?
- -Is the question about stroking the ego, intellectually or otherwise?
- -Is it about legalism?
- -Is it avoiding hard work?



Introduction

The question behind the question...

-Is the question a trap?
Dave agrees with me – I am right!
Dave disagrees with me, is obviously wrong, I do not need to take him seriously anymore.



1 John 2:20-27



-Ultimate truth is found in Jesus v. 20-23.

- -Make sure you remain in Jesus and the Father v. 24.
- -We are taught by the Spirit and do not need another teacher v. 26-27.



1 - God Teaches Us



"...you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit..." v. 27
